

The Gees in Lincolnshire

This report represents a timeline of the Gee family in Lincolnshire. It commences with the arrival Nathaniel Gee (b 1763) in the late 1700s and concludes with the family's departure during the 1870s.

The findings are based on the research of Jack Dennis, my research from a wide range of sources and a visit to the area in 2015. All supporting documents and citations can be found on my Ancestry Tree.
